DOCTORAL COLLOQUIUM

A Doctoral Colloquium will be organized to provide doctoral (PhD or FPM) students a forum to present

their ongoing research for an open discussion. The Doctoral Colloquium will be structured as a series of

short presentations by the students followed by individual discussions, feedback, and advice.

Current PhD/FPM students in the early stages of their program are encouraged to submit a two-page

research summary describing the work in progress and including a 200-word abstract. Things to consider

for inclusion in the research summary might be: the expected contribution to the field; the original idea or

thesis statement; the problem domain and the specific problem addressed; a brief overview of related

work; the methodological approach; research carried out and results so far. The student should be the sole

author, although contributions of the advisor and others should be acknowledged. The Doctoral

Colloquium committee will review submissions to ensure quality, relevance, and potential benefit from

attendance.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

A full paper of 3000 - 5000 words or an abstract of 250 - 300 words should be submitted in Word
