ABOUT CONFERENCE

The conference aims to discuss the organisational, individual and ethical challenges that leaders face in complex and uncertain business environments.

The full day conference will begin with an inaugural session jointly chaired by Professor V. Mukunda Das, Director, CIMP and Chief Patron of the conference and Professor Martin Broad, Head, Southampton Business School. The inaugural session will be followed by two keynote addresses. The first one on "The Mystic Leader" will be delivered by Professor Prasad Sunderarajan, Chandragupt Institute of Management Patna and the second on "Leading Multi-generational Organizations" will be delivered by Professor Paul Bennett, Southampton Business School. This will be followed by a Panel discussion as described below.

PANEL DISCUSSION : IN PURSUIT OF RESPONSIBLE LEADERSHIP

What do leaders need to do in the immediate future to ensure sustainable enterprise? The traditional Key Performance Indicators (KPI's) that many organisations use to measure the performance of senior executives are typically focused on budgets, revenue contribution, product to market, targets, etc. Rarely do they measure the ability of the leaders within an organisation to inspire, motivate, empower and engage their colleagues. Next generation leaders will need to create a great place to be as well as achieve business results.

Responsible leadership behaviours, coupled with technical brilliance,

innovation and commitment to excellence, will certainly lead to improved performance as well as inspiring, aligning and empowering the work force. How will leaders ensure they respond to organizational imperatives whilst maintaining an ethical and moral compass? How will they create a leadership agenda that has at its core, social and environmental performance as well as economic performance? The earliest studies of leadership concluded that character and integrity were as important as capability, in a leader. There can be little doubt we are now living in a time of unprecedented ambiguity and volatility. How can leaders' best prepare to thrive and succeed in the new world order? How will leaders ensure their organizations are fit for the future? Success will not only be about doing business, but also about how business is done and how value is created. In an increasingly complex environment, the integrity of the individual business leader will matter. Six Panelists will be discussing on the above issue. The discussion will be chaired by Prof. Prasad Sundararajan, CIMP who will moderate the discussion.
