Chandragupt Institute of Management Patna (CIMP) was born out of CM Nitish Kumar's dream; a dream of establishing a management and research institution in Bihar on the lines of the IIMs. Thus, CIMP was established in 2008 under the chairmanship of the CM himself. The Institute is fully funded by the state government, and to propel it into the league of premier management institutions of the country, Dr V Mukunda Das, Professor at the renowned IRMA, was brought on board as its Director. Dr Das, a prodigy of Dr Verghese Kurien, of Amul fame, put in relentless efforts to realise the CM's dream. Faculty members were handpicked from top B-Schools of the country such as IIMs, IRMA, XLRI, IIT etc, and the two-year Postgraduate Diploma in Management was started at CIMP.

The institute facilitated campus placements right from its first batch, with CIMP students bagging a place in organisations like Amul, ITC, Comfed, KPMG, ICICI, SEBI, RBI, Jeevika etc at lucrative packages. Thereafter, these companies and others like Nestle, Colgate, L&T, Airtel etc, have been regular recruiters at CIMP.

FOCUS ON SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

- **Students Guidance Centre (SGC):**
An initiative for helping SC/ST/OBC students of Bihar by providing them free coaching, to help them gain admission to IIMs and other management institutes
- **Beautiful Mind:**
To provide education opportunities to students who belong to socially and economically deprived segments of society

Within a short time, CIMP has been honoured with two national and five international awards for academic excellence. Notably, in a survey by University of Connecticut in 2010, CIMP was ranked among Top 20 institutes for Economics and Finance research, above IIM Ahmedabad which ranked 22nd. Additionally, the faculty members and students of CIMP have presented papers in various national and international conferences including Oxford, Harvard, NTU Singapore, etc.

Besides management studies, CIMP has also collaborated and worked on various projects as a research and consulting agency. These include more than 50 national and international projects with organisations such as World Bank, DFID-UK, UNICEF, Election Commission of India, Sarv Shiksha Abhiyan etc. In fact, CIMP is a

registered vendor for providing consultancy services to the World Bank. Around 125 training programmes have been conducted at CIMP under Management Development Programme, for more than 4,000 top administrative, police and education officers of the state. Additionally, the institute has successfully organized more than 200 workshops and seminars on various issues such as Stress Management, Crisis Management, Effective Managerial Leadership, etc.

To keep up its standards of excellence, CIMP shifted into its new campus in July 2015. This campus is spread over 10 acres in the heart of Patna and is equipped with state-of-the-art ultra modern infrastructure to facilitate learning and research.

Most importantly, it is the first management institute in India to have implemented the Reservation
