Dr. Ashutosh Upadhayaya, Director, DLWM ICAR-RCER Patna also mention learning from the holy book GITA:

Leader should have able to face any adverse situation, should not be weaken by pain and pleasure. Have to selfishness desire, exercising compassion and selfless service. Leader should not have fear and anger; most important is character (nobody can harm to you). Lord Krishna defines three specific disciplines - learning, speaking properly, and equanimity. Communicate with honesty and with respect towards others and able to motivate their followers and guide them toward the common vision and goals. We should not over excite in good times and overtly depressed in bad times. Keeping a composed mindset at all times helps us to achieve more peace and happiness in our lives.

Later on he also said that In any kind of management institute 60% are average student and leader have to monitor them and motivate always to do better, and 20% top student they should have provide facility to do more better. He also said that nobody is perfect in this world take help from others and understand the weakness and strength of others.

He also talked about the management guidelines from Gita:

Effectiveness and efficiency is important, forming a vision, planning strategy and analyse them, is an art of leadership, developing human resource, building team and team works. He also emphasises on to put your heart and soul in whatever you do, don't be success hungry. Be optimistic but keep your emotions in control. If you fail you won't be downhearted.
